Dear Participant:

We are looking forward to your participation in our 7th annual Fourth of July Parade. Plan to arrive between 8:00 and 8:30 AM. ***All of the marchers and vehicles must enter the staging area from Business Route 1 and Veterans Hwy. Please notify everyone in your group.***

1. You will stage along Veterans Hwy (aka Rt. 413) and/or in the parking lot of the Veterinary Specialty & Emergency Center. Check in with a Parade Committee member and be given further directions. We will march 1.6 miles from Veterans Memorial Park to Twin Oaks Park on Trenton Road. Arrangements should be made to have your group picked up at Twin Oaks. There will be parking at Twin Oaks Park for buses and some cars. You are free to continue on to your next destination or return to the staging area once the unit crosses over Woodbourne Road. There is no post parade program.

2. **Families who are marching have the option of starting at Veterans Park or joining the parade at the Middletown Community Center at 2140 Trenton Road. You must notify Paul if you are joining at the Community Center so we have someone there to get you in the correct spot.**

4. Certificate of Insurance is required if you are using a vehicle. If you have not already provided it, have your insurance company fax it to 215-750-3801 or email to Paul. The emergency response vehicles (Fire and EMS vehicles) are exempt.
5. There is limited parking at the staging area so we are recommending that groups meet off site and car pool to the staging area. Groups are welcome to meet at the Municipal Center parking lot, 3 Municipal Way, Langhorne. Please let Paul know in advance.
6. In order to keep the parade on schedule all units must keep moving. Please notify all of your drivers that they must not stop to greet the crowd. The military vehicles in the parade are air-cooled and must keep moving.
