


Lower Southampton Township Comprehensive Plan 2010


Online Survey – sample responses

101 Responses to Date


- What kind of comments are we seeing?
 - "I am mostly in the area of <u>Core Creek park</u>. Drivers use the surrounding roads as a speed way."
 - "There are <u>no safe ways to cross I-295</u>. Both Trenton Rd and Bus-1 are incredibly unsafe for Pedestrians and Bicyclists."
 - "To increase bicycle use you need <u>bicycle racks</u> where bikes can be locked up **while shopping, at public parks, etc**"
 - <u>Woodbourne station</u> has such potential but is **inaccessible** from my neighborhood (Maple Point) by bike/foot.
 - Frosty Hollow Rd from Durham Rd to Rt 413 really could benefit from a sidewalk.
 - More trails that are accessible for the disabled. These trails have to be smooth from start to end with no grass, gravel, high cracks, or stones.






Online Survey – question about walking















Online Survey – question for motorists
































Next Steps
