

Middletown Township Board of Supervisors Invites Residents to Help Shape 2026 Budget

Middletown Township, Bucks County - The Middletown Township Board of Supervisors will hold a Capital Budget Workshop on Monday, August 18, 2025, at 5:30 PM at the Raymond P. Mongillo Community Center, 2140 Trenton Road, Levittown.

This workshop kicks off the Township's 2026 budget development process. This is the public's first opportunity to engage with Township officials about proposed capital improvement projects and to learn more about the process of developing a municipal budget.

The meeting will include an overview of budget processes and key terms, followed by department heads sharing the projects they're proposing for 2026. There will be time for questions and public comments, and all residents present at the meeting are encouraged to join in the conversation and share their thoughts. The Township will be unveiling a new and fun way to participate during the meeting.

"Our goal is to make the budget process transparent and inclusive," said Mike Ksiazek, Chairperson of the Middletown Township Board of Supervisors. "By attending this workshop, residents can better understand how capital projects are prioritized and help us make informed decisions about investments into Township infrastructure and enhancements of Township services."

Township Manager Eden Ratliff emphasized the importance of public participation, adding, "The budget is about setting strategic priorities for the coming year focusing on projects that impact our daily lives. Public participation in the budget development process ensures that the adopted budget reflects the needs and values of this community."
