Patrick discussed the offer to the EAC by the township supervisors:

JM Pereira & Sons (concrete contractors) are not able to replace the 400 trees on the property being expanded. In turn, a monetary sum (a fee in lieu of) will be paid to the Twp. in a separate account. This account will provide monies for trees to be planted elsewhere in the Twp and the EAC will provide suggested locations. The EAC voted 7-0 in favor of the fee in lieu of proposal on the Pereira development. Shady Brook was also discussed. (see attached).
