Office building (old building will be demolished).

Front parking on asphalt and stone. 30,000 sq ft earth disturbance. Storm water management should be proposed. Impervious area is reduced by stone parking lot. No flood plains on site. No steep slopes on site. Woodlands in environmentally sensitive area not on this site. Trees are being removed. 49% of woodland area are being removed, and being replaced with 40+trees. No wetlands on site or downstream. Need clarification on 49%. Maintenance of new trees needs to be considered. Lauren suggested that there is criteria needs to be met according to code.
