School Bus Safety Enforcement Program Launching Across Neshaminy School District

In a proactive effort to protect students and promote safe driving, the Neshaminy School District and the six police departments serving the district have partnered with BusPatrol to launch a new school bus safety enforcement program.

Beginning August 27, 2025, the first day of school, all 102 Neshaminy School District buses will be equipped with advanced photo enforcement technology designed to identify vehicles that illegally pass stopped school buses. This reckless behavior endangers the lives of children boarding and exiting buses each day.

Video evidence of alleged violations will be sent to the police department where the incident occurred. Each department — Middletown Township, Lower Southampton Township, Langhorne Borough, Langhorne Manor Borough, Hulmeville Borough, and Penndel Borough — will review the video and determine whether a civil citation should be issued. Motorists found in violation will face a \$300 fine.

Other communities that use BusPatrol technology have seen violations drop by more than 40%. That means drivers are learning, changing their behavior, and helping to keep children safe.

The Middletown Township Police Department, along with our partner agencies in Lower Southampton Township, Langhorne Borough, Langhorne Manor Borough, Hulmeville Borough, and Penndel Borough, urges all motorists to review Pennsylvania's School Bus Stopping Laws and commit to driving responsibly as the school year begins.
