Tree Planting and Care

Don't let the little tubeling dry out or expose it to too much sunlight. When you get home, find a shady spot in your yard (an existing landscape bed works great). Gently tease out the roots out and plant the tubeling in a pot partway into the ground. Water and mulch well. Water once a week, or more often if it is hot and dry. In the early Fall, you can transplant the tree/scrub to the final location in your yard.
