### **VACATION OF STREETS**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

### PART I – PETITION

Complete "petition" with names of all adjoining property owners. Adjoining property owners are those who are immediately affected by vacation of a street.

All adjoining property owners must sign the petition. Signatures are to be notarized.

#### PART II – AGREEMENT

Complete all blank spaces with dates, names of adjoining property owners, tax parcel numbers of all adjoining property owners, and name of street to be vacated.

Submit completed and signed forms (signatures must be notarized) with exhibits and a cover letter explaining the reason for petitioning the vacation of the street to the Middletown Township Board of Supervisors.

### **EXHIBITS**

- "A" Description of street to be vacated, as it currently exists, must be prepared by a registered engineer or land surveyor.
- "B" Description and plan of street showing the new vacated portion divided among the adjoining property owners also to be prepared by a registered engineer or land surveyor.
- "C" Copy of tax map can be obtained from the Department of Licenses and Inspections at the Middletown Township Municipal Building.
- "D" Certification from all utility companies indicating the presence or absence of utilities in the area to be vacated.
- "E" An escrow in the amount of \$750.00 must be established with the Township for legal and in-house engineering reviews. In addition, a filing fee of \$125.00 must also be submitted at the time of application.
- "F" Ten (10) copies of all plans and documents must be submitted.

NOTE: The attached forms may have to be revised in order to include names and signatures of all adjoining property owners.
