Middletown Township would like to provide the following reminders to ensure that snow can be cleared quickly and safely:

- Vehicles must be moved off the roadway within one hour of the snow beginning to fall
- Do not deposit shoveled snow onto the street - it will just get pushed back when the snow plow comes through
- Fixed basketball nets cannot extend past the curb line, and portable ones should be removed from the street
- Sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours of the end of the snowfall, and residents living on a corner are responsible for the portion of the sidewalk around the corner

Teens from 6 different towns will be coming out to perform in the competition! The winner will receive recording time at R&M Music Studio in Langhorne.

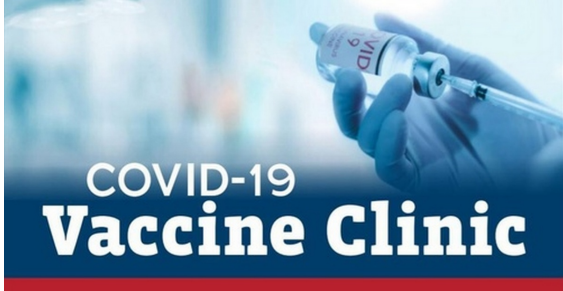

## Bucks County Vaccine Clinics are Reopened With Updated Hours

Bucks County has reopened its vaccine clinics with updated hours and locations after a brief holiday closure.



Vaccines will continue to be administered at no cost to recipients, with primary and booster doses of the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines available at each site. Pediatric doses also will be available. Clinics are open exclusively to walk-ins.

Clinics are located at Bucks County Community College, Warwick Square, and the Neshaminy Mall. Their hours are as follows:

The Middletown Township Police Department has designated the Middletown Township Police Department Lobby at 3 Municipal Way, Langhorne PA 19047, a "Safe Exchange Zone" to provide residents a safe environment to buy, sell, or trade items in private party transactions, with people they don't know.



This is a great resource for exchanging goods you may be coordinating online, such as Facebook Marketplace or Craigslist. Using a Safe Exchange Zone allows you to meet someone to exchange goods without disclosing your home or work address.
