

At its December 17th meeting, the Middletown Township Board of Supervisors voted to adopt the 2026 Township Budget, following several months of public meetings, discussions, and community engagement.

The adopted budget includes modest reductions to the originally proposed real estate tax increase while maintaining critical investments in Township services and infrastructure.
