## Blue Envelope Program Launches in Middletown Township

The Middletown Township Police Department is proud to introduce the Blue Envelope Program, a new voluntary initiative designed to support individuals with autism spectrum disorder (ASD) during traffic stops. This program aims to foster clearer, safer



communication between law enforcement officers and drivers who may have unique communication needs.

Each blue envelope provides a designated space for individuals to store their driver's license, registration, and insurance documents. It also includes communication tools to help the driver and officer navigate the interaction more smoothly. Additionally, officers receive guidance on how to recognize and respectfully engage with individuals on the spectrum, enhancing understanding and safety on both sides.

### How to Receive a Blue Envelope:

- **In Person:** Visit the Middletown Township Police Department lobby during regular business hours.
- **Home Delivery:** If you are unable to visit in person, call 215-750-3845 (press 2 for the administrative assistants) to request an envelope be delivered to your Middletown address.
- **Community Events:** Blue envelopes will also be available at various community events throughout the year.

This program is one more step in the Police Department's commitment to building an inclusive and compassionate community where every resident is treated with dignity and respect.

## Household Hazardous Waste Event Hosted by Bucks County

Bucks County will be holding a Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection event on Saturday, August 9th, at Bucks County Technical School (610 Wistar Road, Fairless Hills, Bristol Township). The event will be held from 8:30 AM to 2:00 PM and is free for all Bucks County

residents. Registration is not required.

Household products containing toxic chemicals, like pesticides, oil-based paints, solvents, cleaning products, weed killers and automotive batteries can be a threat to people and the environment if improperly discarded. Never throw these materials into the trash, as the toxic chemicals may harm sanitation workers, or result in fires in collection vehicles. It is also not safe to pour them into a sink or storm drain as they can end up in the environment polluting the air, water, or soil. Residents may bring up to 25 gallons or 220 pounds of hazardous products. Hazardous products will have cautionary words on labels for example: Danger, Warning, or Caution. Middletown Township Board of Supervisors recognized July as Disability Pride Month at their meeting on Monday, July 14, 2025. Disability Pride Month is celebrated nationally during the month of July to commemorate the passing of the landmark Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) in July 1990. The ADA was passed to prohibit discrimination and ensure the rights of people with disabilities.

July is a time to recognize and celebrate how disabilities are a natural part of human diversity in which people can take pride. Disability Pride Month celebrates all 1 billion disabled people, 15% of the world's

population, their identities and culture, and contributions to society. People with disabilities are the largest and most diverse minority in the United States making up approximately 26% of the population with people representing all ages, races, ethnicities, genders, sexual orientations, religions, and socio-economic backgrounds.
