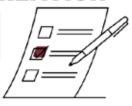

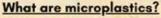




The Particles We Consume Every Day.

- Plastics no greater than 5 mm in size.
 - 1. Primary microplastics: enter the environment through spills or washing
- Secondary microplastics: fragments of large plastics that have broken off due to weathering from water, wind, UV rays
- Products with microplastics include;
 - Cosmetic products, fertilizer, cleaning supplies, detergent, & plant protection products

Why should we care?

- · Microplastics are NOT biodegradable
- · 42,000 tons of microplastics are deposited into the environment each year (ECHA)
- Research is limited, but microplastics may contain chemicals toxic to our bodily functions, leading to cellular damage, inflammation, and possibly cancer.
 (Savchuk, 2025, Stanford Medicine News Center)

How can we help?

- Reduce microplastics by vacuuming and dust regularly to avoid airborne microplastics, and line-drying clothing to reduce fiber loss
- Reuse containers for food and storage, use metal or wooden kitchen utensils, and REUSABLE SHOPPING BAGS!!!
- Avoid plastic bottles and opt for glass or steel water bottles, do not heat plastic, and adopt a filtration system for water
